The Foundation FSSC published FSSC 22000 Version 7.0 in May 2026 as part of its ongoing commitment to strengthen global food safety standards and align with evolving industry expectations. This transition marks the next phase in the development of the Scheme, building on the requirements of Version 6.0.
